P.E. Clothes:

- T-Shirt: solid colored navy blue, black, maroon, white, gray (or AHCS spirit wear). Note: a small logo (less than 2 inches) on the front of the shirt is permitted.
- Athletic Shorts/Pants: solid colored navy blue, black, maroon, or gray (stripes in these colors on the side is permitted).
- Yoga pants (not leggings) are acceptable. Shorts must be mid-thigh in length or longer. Spandex bike shorts are acceptable as long as they meet the length requirement.
- Athletic shoes are required. Any type of tennis shoe, vans, converse, etc. are acceptable. Boots, flats, or any type of shoe with a platform is not allowed.
- Stick deodorant to keep in the P.E. locker (spray deodorant is not allowed).
- Students will start dressing out the third week of school.
